## Discover the local journey of wildlife

Discover Toyooka's journey and unprecedented efforts to protect and reintroduce storks back into the wild. Thanks to the captive breeding activities, this once-extinct wild animal is now slowly flying back into Japan's sky. Stroll through the town to meet wild storks with a private guide.

Genbudo Park houses five caves formed by a volcanic eruption from approximately 1.6 million years ago. The largest of the five, Genbudo Cave, was used as a quarry in the 1600s and is a natural heritage site of the San'in Kaigan UNESCO Global Geopark. Genbudo Cave is also an important geographical point of habitat for the storks.
