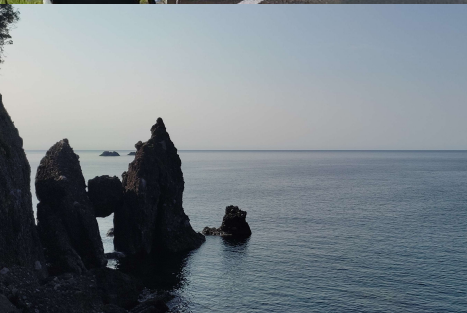

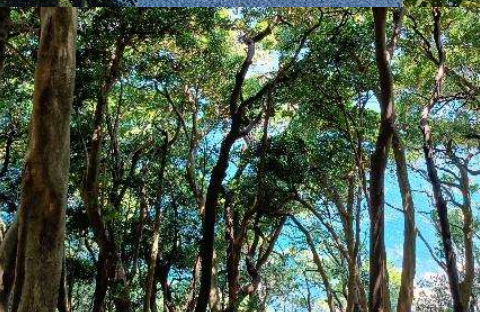

Nekozaki Hiking with Geopark Guide

Nekozaki Peninsula is the northernmost point of Hyogo Prefecture and a stop along the San'in Kaigan UNESCO Global Geopark. The hike is two hours roundtrip, and the view at the top is unmatched - the northernmost point of Hyogo Prefecture paints the Sea of Japan's aquamarine waters on a mesmerizing panoramic canvas.

Takeno Salt Creation and Beach Cleaning

During the Edo period (1603-1868), it was customary to pay salt rather than rice as tribute in Takeno. Before World War II, however, the production of salt started to become forbidden to prevent the spread of wealth in the region, so the work disappeared. Salt-making was revived as a community project in 2010. The salt made in Takeno is used for seasoning, ice creams, puddings, cakes, and is also sold as a souvenir in hotels, inns, and restaurants in the area, as well as in Osaka and Kobe.
